

Job Posting – Tissue Processing Technician

Lake Superior Centre for Regenerative Medicine- RegenMed

RegenMed is a growing company serving Canadians in the field of regenerative medicine. We are a tissue bank providing surgeons with allografts for trauma and transplant procedures.

The Position: RegenMed will train someone to become a Tissue Processing Technician. In the first year, we expect this job will yield between 16 -30 hours per week and sometimes more as required. With expansion plans underway, we expect this position could be made full time in the second year of employment. The pay range will be consistent with tissue banking industry standards.

Requirements:

- A diploma/degree in nursing or life/health sciences, or any course of study that includes a focus on anatomy, or a combination of formal training and work experience;
- Willingness to obtain AATB Tissue Banking Specialist training and certification; and the ability to be productive and work well in a team setting.
- Experience with protocol validation or research processes would be valuable.
- The candidate must be able to lift up to 50 pounds, stand for long hours, push up to 50 pounds of equipment and use repetitive hand motions.

Responsibilities:

- Perform all aspects of processing tissue (debridement, dissection, cutting, cleaning and disinfection, sizing, assessing) according to current procedures and protocols in compliance with federal and AATB regulations and standards;
- Perform all aspects of packaging and preservation of tissue products (confirmation of sizing, quality, packaging materials, cryopreservation, etc.);
- Accurately and thoroughly document all processes and functions performed;

- Perform post-processing decontamination of equipment and the processing room;
- Perform accurate and timely post production and/or post packaging documentation reviews; and
- Assist in production enhancement and improvement initiatives.
- Assist where capable in the operational aspects of the tissue bank
